

## Good and taboo can for ability questions

Pick one question each from the list on the next page and read it out. Together decide which of those questions is the easiest most normal question to answer for people like you, then the person who was asked that question should answer it. Then do the same with two more questions. You can choose the questions as quickly or slowly as you like each time, but the person who chooses first gets first pick each time.

## Useful phrases for discussing which question is best

"I think my question is more common/ easier to answer/ better with people who you don't know, because..."

"I think that your question is strange/ not suitable to ask me/ too personal/ taboo because..."

Ask about any questions which you don't understand, you are not sure how to answer, you are not sure about the suitability of, etc.
